Exodus 3 vs 7-10

The LORD said, "I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. ⁸ So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. ⁹ And now the cry of the Israelites has reached me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians oppress them. ¹⁰ So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

This reading follows Moses realisation of God's presence through the sign of fire; but convincing people that it was God's rescue plan was a task in itself. 2-3 million people left Egypt; the line of people would have measured 150 miles. The journey from Egypt was about 240 miles, walking

at a slow pace, 5 miles a day, they would easily have reached Canaan in 58 days - yet they took 40 years!!!! Instead of seeing God's signs along the way, they focused on their own fear, rage, self-centredness, wants, and were easily led by other people's convincing arguments. They made life so much more difficult for themselves, it became a chore rather than a joy.

What do we see as God's signs for us? Do we need thunderbolts, flashes of light, a loud audible voice? Or can we learn to recognise His Spiritual Energy and Power working in the ordinary things of life to give us a positive outlook, contentment, and hope for the hour, the day, the future? My friend Ade wrote this inspiring and thought-provoking story called "Give me a sign"

.....A man awakes from a restless night in the early hours of the morning. As he lies there waiting for sleep to return, in his mind he is asking the question " God if you exist give me a sign". Nothing happens! and he falls back into a uneasy sleep

He dreams he meets a man and they are walking along a road and as they walk he tells the man of his earlier question to God. "I asked for a sign!" he says..

""Well there's a sign there" the man says, as he points to the Street name at the end of the road where the man lives. Our Dreamer laughs and says "No, I wanted a sign that tells me of the existence of God"

They walk further along the road and again the man says "there's one" as he points to the sign on the outside of a church. Again our dreamer laughs and says "No, that's a sign for a place for people who already believe in God".

"Oh okay" said the man they carry on walking and day turns to a clear but cold night. Our dreamers' travelling companion adjusts his glasses and points to the stars in the sky and says "are they not signs in the heavens?" Our dreamer ponders the question and replies "it's true that in years gone by sailors used star positions to find their way and they have been there for millions of years, but they are not proof God exists"

They walk on and the night breaks to an overcast morning and our travelling companion breaks the silence between the two men - "can I tell you what I saw when I saw all those signs we have seen on our journey?" Rather wearily the dreamer replies "Oh go on then"

"When I saw the street sign at the end of your road I saw the sign that meant you were home and near to all that you hold dear, a place surrounded by love."

"When I saw the sign for the church I saw a sign for a place where people find safety solace and love regardless of their background or religion"

"When I saw the stars in the sky I saw all the people who have come into your life and made it better, guided you towards good, away from trouble, and towards God.

"Wow" said our dreamer "you saw all that, I think I need to borrow your glasses" and with that the man took the glasses from his nose and passed them to the dreamer. The dreamer placed them on his nose and looked to the sky, "what do you see" asked the companion?"
