#### Reflection

I have been gifted a book where the main character gets the chance to experience different lives that she could have lived if she had chosen alternative paths throughout her life. Whichever life thread she experiences, there may be positive aspects, but she is often left not feeling satisfied, still yearning to live life another way. She has regrets. In reality, we have just one life. God wants our life to be the best it can be, not by our own striving and manipulation, but by relying on His grace and forgiveness and mercy. Life will always bring difficulties and problems.

As Jesus says in John 16:33, 'In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.'

When we encounter Jesus for ourselves, just like Matthew the tax collector did, the whole focus of our life changes. Matthew gave up a lucrative job to follow Jesus.
