Mark 1 vs 1-13 - John the Baptist Prepares the Way

1 The beginning of the good news about Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God, as it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "I will send my messenger ahead of you,

"a voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord,

make straight paths for him." And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

REFLECTION If we had been there on this day we would have seen lines of people, maybe heads bowed in prayer, we would have heard water splashing and maybe quiet words John spoke to the ones turning their lives around and over to the Saviour just before Baptism. These ordinary folk were called by God, through John the Baptist words, to REPENT. Repentance is not a word used very much today. Repentance means to change the mind, so what does it really mean for people today, for us.

We have previously lived, moved in one direction, and when we repent we turn and move in another direction. Previously it was a direction of selfishness, greed, envy, lies, anger, being in competition with others. Then comes a time when God seems to be calling, in a silent whisper, with a gentle nudge, for us to change our mind concerning those mental attitudes and life-styles. It's a huge moment, it's a very big deal.

Bad attitudes and actions make life miserable for others, and often for the ones going in that direction, even if they don't admit it. And none of us, even if we have turned in Jesus direction, are immune from these ways. Maybe not in every conversation and every action, less occasionally, but they still creep in to our days. They cause feelings of guilt which can eat away at us.

The act of dedicating our lives to Jesus is for most a one time commitment, but the call of John to repentance, being saved, is ongoing. And when we consciously make these prayerful decisions, often daily, it's cleaning and renewing, refreshing and revitalising just like water. We have moved through the celebration of Pentecost Sunday, when the disciples were drenched with the Holy Spirit, and enabled to do things they didn't think possible. Maybe there are things in our lives, about our personalities or life-styles, which we think can never be changed. On our own it's not possible, but with the Holy Spirit all things are possible.

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us. Eph 3:20



A prayer of confession - Merciful God, we pause to contemplate your beauty and the perfection of your being and we are acutely aware of our own unworthiness, and our sin (all that damages and blocks relationships between ourselves and God, and others). We confess that often our heavenly vision is obstructed by worldly desires, our selfishness and self-indulgence overrules your will, our fear, needs or desires stop us loving. We stifle and bind our own lives, when your immeasurable riches & grace are freely available to all who put their trust in You. Lord we repent, change our minds, and receive your words of forgiveness, we breathe in your Holy Spirit and endeavour now to fully follow You once again. AMEN
